De André” with the cooperation of the European Fencing Confederation (EFC), the Italian Fencing Federation (FIS), the Municipality of Pisa, the Council of the Tuscany Country, is proud to organize the **“XIV International Tournaments of Cadets” on 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> of the February, 2012.**

<b>Age category</b>	Cadet boys and girls born in 1995 or younger (until 1998)
<b>Venue</b>	<p>Impianti CUS Pisa, Via Napoli, 49 56123 Pisa (Italy)</p> 
<b>Organization</b>	CS Navacchio Polisportiva ASD, CS Valdera and CS F. De André
<b>Registration / Entries</b>	<p>The competition is open to all countries. All entries must be made through the fencer's national federation via the EFC website (<a href="http://www.eurofencing.info">http://www.eurofencing.info</a>) <b>7 days before the scheduled events</b>. As per the 2011-2012 EFC regulations, no more than 20 entries per country can be accepted apart from the host.</p> <p>Overseas entries are restricted to <b>20 entries per nation, 64 to Italians</b>.</p> <p><b>Entry fee: €15 per fencer to be paid at the check-in.</b></p>
<b>Competition format</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>FIE JWC formula, one round of pool of 6-7 fencers</b>, at least 20% with a maximum of 30% eliminated after the round, followed by direct elimination table without repechage</li> <li>• Finals without fence-off for 3<sup>rd</sup> place.</li> </ul> <p>EFC regulations will apply throughout the competition. Trophy for the top 8.</p>
<b>Referees</b>	<p>According with EFC rules, each participating country must supply at its expense the number of qualified referees indicated in the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 1-4 fencers, no referee required</li> <li>• 5-9 fencers, 1 referee</li> <li>• 10-15 fencers, 2 referees</li> <li>• 16-20 fencers, 3 referees.</li> </ul> <p>Failure to comply with the rule will result in a 500 € fine for each referee short of the required number.</p> <p>This fee must be paid before any fencers from the offending country will be allowed to compete.</p> <p><b>The registration of the referees must be made through the fencer's national federation via the EFC website before 7 days from the event.</b></p>

<b>Equipment</b>	FIE Standard equipment will be required, i.e. 800N clothing, 1600N mask and FIE approved blade. CE mark is mandatory in the clothing and mask. Printing of the fencer's name on the back of the jacket is not required.	
<b>Liability</b>	The organizer doesn't take any liability.
